California is in its 4th year of a very serious drought. On April 1, 2015, Governor Brown issued an Executive Order that requires a statewide reduction in potable water use. To achieve the State's water conservation goal, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors will hold a hearing to consider implementation of the Phased Water Conservation Plan under Part 5 of the Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and the Marina del Rey Water System. The hearing will be held on May 26, 2015, at 9:30 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Board, Room 381, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, 90012.

Waterworks District No. 40 customers must collectively reduce the volume of water used in 2013 by 32 percent. To assist you in managing your water use, the following table shows your Target Quantity (Allocation) and 2014 bi-monthly water use measured in units of 100 cubic feet (1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons).

Under the Phased Water Conservation Plan, customers are charged the normal water rate for all the water they use. A conservation surcharge of 1 time the normal water rate is charged for the first 15 percent of water use above their target quantity. An additional conservation surcharge of 2 times the normal water rate is charged for water use in excess of the first 15 percent above the target quantity.

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) has imposed stringent water use restrictions on communities across the State. The SWRCB has also prohibited the following activities:

- Washing down sidewalks and driveways
- Watering outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes excess runoff
- Washing a motor vehicle with a hose, unless the hose is fitted with a shut-off nozzle
- Operating a fountain or decorative water feature, unless the water is part of a recirculating system
- Irrigating turf or ornamental landscapes during and 48 hours following measurable precipitation
