Narrative:

On November 11, 2015 at approximately 4:00 PM, Lancaster Station deputies were dispatched to the 40000 block of 166th Street East, in response to a vicious dog call for service. The call had been placed by the dog's owner after it attacked his 13 year old nephew in the backyard of the residence. The victim and his owner were in the rear yard preparing to feed the pit-bull, when it suddenly attacked the victim by biting him on the right arm. The child's uncle was able to free him from the dog's grasp, and he was flown by Los Angeles County Sheriff's Air Rescue 5, to Children's Hospital Los Angeles. The extent of the child's injuries are unknown at this time. Officers from Los Angeles County Animal Care and Control responded to the location and took custody of the dog at the owner's request. No citations were issued, and no arrests have been made at this time.
