Narrative:

On Monday February 8, 2016 deputies from the Lancaster Burglary Suppression Team served a search warrant in the 1400 block of West Avenue H-15. Items taken during recent burglaries were located and recovered. Additionally, other items believed to be stolen were seized as well. The total dollar amount of seized property was over \$85,000.00 which consisted of a Rolex watch, diamond jewelry, collector coins, a road bike, collector electric guitar, and miscellaneous electronics. Currently, twenty victims of residential burglary have identified items of property recovered from the suspects' residence. During the service of the search warrant one suspect was located at the residence. Additional victims are being sought as deputies continue to sort through the recovered property. The investigation is being handled by the Lancaster Burglary Suppression Team.
